

Scoutscroft Disability Access Statement

Scoutscroft Leisure Park welcomes people with disabilities and has developed this Access Statement to address some of the common issues which disabled people may face. We are a pet friendly park and guide dogs are permitted throughout.

We aim to ensure that all employees, guests and others who use the park and its facilities are treated equally and according to their needs.

Pre-arrival

For any help or assistance prior to arrival, we advise contacting our Reception or Holiday Sales team.

Reception and complex entrance

We have two designated disabled parking spaces in the main carpark which can be used for both Reception and the complex. All the facilities within the complex are accessible with ramps or flat access. There are disabled access toilets in both bars.

Public areas

Access around the park is fairly flat, and all the roads are tarmacked. The launderette is accessible via a ramp.

Accommodation

We offer one accessible caravan with all the usual comforts and additional specific features designed for guests with limited mobility which include manual hoist, large bathroom, lowered kitchen counters, large bedroom allowing space to manoeuvre and external ramp access to the accommodation itself. Each of our holiday accommodation has its own dedicated car parking space.

Local area

Coldingham is very accessible for motorised scooters and wheelchairs and there is disabled parking right down next to the beach to take in the views. Eyemouth is very flat and is a great place to visit as the harbour and beach are both accessible.
